Our crew has been extremely busy over the last month. It is hard to believe that we have made it to the middle of September. Work continued in the park until the 1st of the month, clearing the downed trees on and along the trails. The process involves cutting and dragging the brush to the parking area and then chipping the limbs into a truck. Once the roadwork on Sugar Mountain Drive slows down, we will resume the project. As far as the roadwork is concerned, when the road was built in the mid 1960's it appears the area beyond the tennis courts was built up using whatever material was available at the time. Beam Construction has had to excavate over 25 feet in depth to remove the unsuitable material under the roadway. It was also discovered that the roadway had slipped back in the early 2000's and the repair then was a good cosmetic cover-up. After seeing the dirt, brush and trash that was excavated, I cannot believe we have not had a major slide on that section before now. This work is going to take several more weeks to complete, but in the end it will make for a much safer road to travel on. The material that is being removed from the area is being stored at our dump site on the golf course for the time being, and some of it will be suitable for use during the stream restoration project. Today we had a meeting with Northstate Environmental regarding the start date of the golf course project. They anticipate starting by the first of October, with a projected completion date of mid March. Our paving for this summer has been completed and we will be planning to get the newly paved areas striped with white and yellow lines as soon as we possibly can.

I will be out of town from September 19 through the 28th. I am traveling to San Diego, California to drive back across the country with my son that is being relocated to Camp Lejeune, NC.
